I am a registered dramatherapist and an elected member of the executive council of The Irish Association of Creative Arts Therapists (IACAT) and Coordinator of DvT Dramatherapy Ireland. DvT is a drama therapy technique, unique to this method is that the therapist physically interacts with the client to create a space where anxieties can be realised. Trained in Ireland, the UK and the USA I bring a trauma informed approach to my practice. I appreciate a fully transparent dialogue with clients, parents and employers. I adhere to a strong ethos of clinical honesty for my clients to recognise their potential.

My career path, from a theatre practitioner and venue manager to a dramatherapist has afforded me a unique insight into working with children and adults.

Interventions

- Open and regular dialogue with parents regarding family situation and parents own trauma.
- Co-created space with clients to physically and metaphorically engage with their trauma on a pre-verbal level.
- De-coding client's trauma schema towards a verbal recognition of their situation and potential for change.
- Fostered collaborative play that names the clients trauma allowing direct cognitive reflection on the trauma while being physically engaged.

DvT Dramatherapist

Post Traumatic Stress Centre / New Haven CT, USA / June - August 2017 Supervised within the centre's clinical team to deliver in-school and out of school treatment to identified students both at elementary and high school level.

Interventions

- A.L.I.V.E programme (Elementary). The purposeful introduction of anxiety
 provoking reminders of the student's life into the supportive play
 environment to aid stress reduction and foster educational learning
 capabilities. Promotes executive function and self-regulation.
- STRONG programme (High School). Summer out of school peer leadership
 and personal development with a focus on students' stressors and triggers.
 Students also receive one to one therapeutic trauma informed intervention.
 Students develop a creative reflective log of their time in the programme
 which is delivered to their peers at the start of the next academic year.
- Often students from the summer programme will become 'counsellors in training' for the following year's programme.
